4. Motion: Supporting the UCU (University and Colleges Union) Strikes

Motion proposed by: Laurence Peinturier

Motion seconded by: Felice Wallner

The MCR notes that:

- Academic staff at the University of Oxford in the University and Colleges Union are going on strike for 18 days during Hilary term 2023;
- They are doing so because they believe they are not being fairly treated by the University.

The MCR believes that:

- Academic staff deserve fair compensation for their labour;
- Both students and staff suffer from staff's current unfair working conditions:
- Student support in the dispute will help the UCU come to a quicker resolution with the University.

The MCR resolves to:

- Support academic staff at the University of Oxford in the University and Colleges Union through their period of industrial action.
- Donate £50 to the Oxford UCU Hardship Fund.

Discussion:

- *Karan: How are we interacting with them? And who does it involve?*
- Jeremy: We can negotiate outcomes and solutions to class cancellations etc for example. It involves profs, staff, postgrads who are teaching etc.
- Jeremy: I agree with the motion except the last part which is donating 50 pounds. Catz is a charity; Worried about the fact that we are a charity donating to another charity.
- Hannah: We could discuss other donations to another charity as well if we are only allowed one donation per Open Meeting.
- *Web: Are we voting for both items of the motion together?*
- Jeremy: yes

Motion called to vote: passed with a majority (17 for, 3 no, 1 abstain)

1. Update on Gym Renovation
